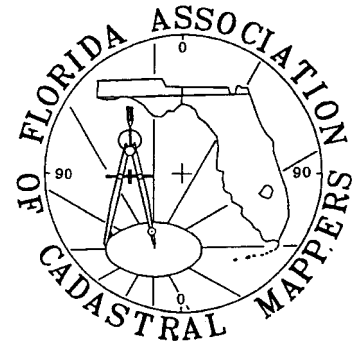

Advanced Cadastral Editing in the ArcMap Environment
